CODE OF CONDUCT

**FOR STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE AUSTRALIA EXCHANGE
JULY 2011 / JANUARY 2012**

The aim of these regulations is to promote harmony within the group and to maintain the safety and well-being of individual students during the group’s time away.

STUDENT REGULATIONS

- 1 Students must always follow the directions of their supervising teacher.
- 2 Students must not behave in any way which would discredit themselves, their family or their School.
- 3 Students must not break the law of the countries they visit.
- 4 No student may leave the group at any time without the permission of the supervising teacher and each student must report back to the supervising teacher on her/his return to the group.
- 5 Students must always move in groups of at least three [3] persons.
- 6 No students may venture away from their place of residence at night unless they are accompanied by an adult or someone designated by the host family.
- 7 No student is permitted to drink alcohol, to smoke or take illicit drugs at any stage during the exchange or entice any other student to do the same.
- 8 All students must attend all lessons with his/her host brother/sister and be attentive and engaged in class.
- 9 All students must be punctual to and participate in all excursions, outings and planned activities organised by the supervising teacher unless they have the express permission from the supervising teacher not to do so
- 10 Any difficulties of a personal, financial or social nature should be communicated to the supervising teacher so that harmony of the group can be safeguarded at all times.

Parents are to keep a copy of the Code of Conduct for personal reference and both the student and his/her parent/guardian must sign and date the agreement form.

CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT
